A.G. - v - Prouse

(Appeal against conviction and sentence imposed by the Police Court on the 15th October, 1984)

Deputy Bailiff:" There is much force in what Miss Nicolle has said, Mr.Benest, as regards being a principal as regards Article 2(1)* and we see no reason to interfere with the Magistrate's decision in the fine of \$60, however, as regards Article 44(A)**, there is much force in what you say in this respect and therefore we are going to reduce the fine to \$10 or 3 days. As regards costs.... no order for costs."
