

A.G. - v - Michael Calter

17th January, 1985

(Appeal against conviction by the Police Court on the
15th October, 1984)

Deputy Bailiff: "We are grateful for the cases cited to us by you Mr.Pallot and by Miss Nicolle and the passages she has drawn our attention to. Bocking*was, of course, not unanimous, Mackenna L.J. had a dissenting judgement and would have allowed the appeal and we find his judgement very persuasive. We have come to the conclusion that there was not a quantity of cannabis resin to the extent that it could be said that your client was in possession of it at the relevant time, February last year, and therefore the appeal is allowed. Legal aid costs."
