The Representation of Robin Frederick Thomas

The Representor on his own behalf.

Judgment

THE DEPUTY BAILIFF: Mr. Thomas, the Court dismisses the first part of your representation. The view we take is that Mr. Pallot is entitled to his costs and to recover them; they have been outstanding for a very long time. If at the end of the day you are proved right then obviously you will be able to make a claim for the costs which you have paid and for the interest on the amount involved. So at the present we reject your representation: we are not prepared to make an order preventing the Viscount from enforcing the judgment, and you must pay the costs.

As far as the second part of the representation is concerned, that will be served, and will come up again two weeks from today.
