## JUDGMENT

<u>DEPUTY BAILIFF</u>: "Very well, the Court will adjourn the matter for three weeks and will remand Cassin in custody with the provision of bail in the sum of £5.00 limited to the period necessary to travel accompanied by the probation officer to Broadreach House in Plymouth for assessment and on his return to surrender himself back into custody to appear here three weeks from today. And it is advisable perhaps that I should preside as I have all the facts of the offences carefully noted under the last date Cassin appeared before the Court (3rd September, 1988). I do not know if I will be sitting in three weeks time and we might have to fix a 12.00 o'clock sitting or something of that kind, if necessary".
