Appeal against a total term of imprisonment of five days imposed following convictions on counts of importation of a controlled drug, possession of a controlled drug and possession of a utensil for the purpose of committing an offence in connection therewith, contrary to Article 23 of the Customs and Excise (General Provisions) (Jersey), Law, 1972, and Articles 6(1) and 8 of the Misuse of Drugs (Jersey) Law, 1978, respectively.

JUDGMENT

THE BAILIFF: Count 1, for importing, we are going to allow the appeal and substitute a fine of £200 or seven days' imprisonment; count 2, for possession, £50 or three days' imprisonment concurrent; count 3, the pipe, £30 or three days' imprisonment concurrent, making a total of £280 or seven days' imprisonment. Mrs. Pearmain, you will have your legal aid costs.
