Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement) (Jersey) Law, 1960

The Judicial Greffier gives notice that in future when an application is made to register a United Kingdom judgment under the above law:-

- (1) the copy of the judgment exhibited to the affidavit of facts required by Rule 4 of the Judgments (Reciprocal Enforcement) (Jersey) Rules, 1951, shall be certified in accordance with the provisions of Order 71, Rule 13 of the Rules of the Supreme Court (See paragraph 71/13/3 for the form of endorsement);
- (2) there shall be exhibited to the affidavit of facts a certificate in the form set out on page 116 of Part 2 of the Supreme Court Practice 1991 (Form PF 155-Certificate A). Where interest is claimed under the terms of the judgment which is sought to be registered, a certificate in the form of Certificate B shall also be exhibited to the affidavit of facts.

This direction supercedes the practice direction issued on this subject on the 4th January, 1989.
