JUDGMENT

THE LIEUTENANT BAILIFF: The Court confirms the Confiscation Order of £1,303 that has already been agreed.

Mr. Landick, we have listened very carefully to what you have said. We have also listened to the Attorney General's reasoned arguments about the benchmark and about the amount of mitigation to be given to your client, with both of which the Court agrees with and therefore we intend to grant the conclusions. Therefore Wood, you are sentenced on cou 1 to $5^{1/2}$ years'; on count 2, to 2 years' concurrent; on count 3, 12 months' concurrent; on count 4, 12 months' concurrent; and on count 5, 3 months' concurrent, making a total of $5^{1/2}$ years' and we order the forfeiture and destruction of the drugs.
