Worked in Jersey for 13 years. Paid no Social Security whatsoever. Arrears of £13,000 - odd. Came to light because statutory change meant he could no longer work without a card. Labour only sub-contractor in construction industry - jobbing builder/plasterer/labourer.

DETAILS OF MITIGATION:

Frank when detected. Few assets, little income.

PREVIOUS CONVICTIONS:

Nil.

CONCLUSIONS:

Charges 1, 3, 5, 7:

£50 or 1 week's imprisonment in default of payment on each charge.

Charges 2, 4, 6, 8:

£125 or 4 weeks' imprisonment in default of payment on each charge.

£550 costs; terms of imprisonment to run consecutively.

TOTAL: £700 or 20 weeks' imprisonment.

SENTENCE AND OBSERVATIONS OF THE COURT:

Charges 1, 3, 6, 7:

£50 or 1 week's imprisonment in default of payment on each charge.

Charges 2, 4, 6, 8:

£100 or 4 weeks' imprisonment in default of payment on each charge.

£100 costs.

Terms of imprisonment to run consecutively.

TOTAL: £600 or 20 weeks' imprisonment.
