The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011

Made - - - -

15th July 2011

Coming into operation -

5th August 2011

The Department for Regional Development(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of, and paragraph 5 of Schedule 4 to, the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a Notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection has been received.

One representation has been received and duly considered.

The Department has modified the Order to take account of the representation.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment No. 6) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011 and shall come into operation on 5th August 2011.

Amendments

(3) Add the items set out in the Schedule to this Order.

3.—(1) Schedule 1 to The Parking Places on Roads (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006(b) shall be amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) Delete the following items—

- (a) item no. 576 relating to Shore Street, Donaghadee;
- (b) item no. 581 relating to William Street, Donaghadee; and
- (c) item no. 1185 relating to Bristol Park, Newtownards.

SCHEDULE

Unlimited Waiting

Article 2 (3)

- “721. Bush Park, Antrim (south-west side) – from a point 98 metres north-east of its junction with Parkhall Road, for a distance of 5 metres.
- 722. Drumbreda Avenue, Armagh (north-west side) – from a point 22 metres north-east of its junction with Drumbreda Walk, for a distance of 3 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- 723. Iveagh Close, Banbridge (south-east side) – from a point 57 metres north-east of its junction with Iveagh Drive for a distance of 6 metres.
- 724. Station Road, Clogher (west side) – from a point 88.5 metres north of its junction with Carleton Road, for a distance of 6.5 metres.
- 725. Kinelownen Street, Keady (south-east side) – from a point 54 metres south-west of its junction with St. Patrick’s Street, for a distance of 6 metres.
- 726. The Square, Moy (south-west side) – from a point 101 metres south-east of its junction with Benburb Road, for a distance of 6 metres in a south-easterly direction.
- 727. Ballinlare Gardens, Newry (north-west side) – from a point 98 metres north of its junction with Killeavey Road, for a distance of 3.6 metres in a westerly direction.
- 728. Barcroft Park, Newry (east side) – from a point 170 metres south of its western junction with Dorans Hill, for a distance of 7.7 metres.
- 729. College Gardens, Newry (south-west side) – from a point 104 metres north-west of its junction with Violet Hill Avenue, for a distance of 5.5 metres.
- 730. Downshire Place, Newry (east side) – from a point 25 metres north of its junction with Church Avenue, for a distance of 5.5 metres.
- 731. Dakota Avenue, Newtownards (east side) – from a point 91 metres south of its junction with Sunderland Park, for a distance of 11 metres.
- 732. Armagh Road Estate, Portadown (south-west side) – from a point 61 metres north-east of its junction with Dorchester Drive, for a distance of 3 metres in a north-easterly direction.
- 733. Railway Street, Poyntzpass (north side) – (in the layby) from a point 5 metres south-east of its junction with Church Street, for a distance of 3 metres in a south-easterly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006 and The Parking Places on Roads (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2006.

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places with unlimited waiting on the lengths of the road specified in the Schedule and the removal of the parking places referred to in Articles 2(2) and 3(2).
