REGISTRATION OF CLUBS

The Registration of Clubs (Irresponsible Drinks Promotions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2012

Laid before the Assembly in draft

Made - - - 6*th December 2012*

The Department for Social Development makes the following Regulations in exercise of the power conferred by Article 31A (1) and (2) of the Registration of Clubs (Northern Ireland) Order 1996(\mathbf{a}) and now vested in it(\mathbf{b}).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Registration of Clubs (Irresponsible Drinks Promotions) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2012 and shall come into operation on 1st January 2013.

Prohibition of irresponsible drinks promotion

2. A registered club shall not carry on an irresponsible drinks promotion (which involves the supply of unlimited amounts of intoxicating liquor for a fixed charge (including any charge for entry to the premises)) on or in connection with the premises of the club.
