ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) (Amendment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 2014**

Made - - - - - *24th November 2014*

Coming into operation - *15th December 2014*

The Department for Regional Development(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2014 and shall come into operation on 15th December 2014.

Amendment

2. The Parking and Waiting Restrictions (Belfast) Order (Northern Ireland) 2008(d) is amended by the addition to Part II of Schedule 2 of the following item—

“9. Stewart Street (west side) – from a point 15 metres south of its junction with East Bridge Street for a distance of 108 metres in a southerly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prohibits vehicles waiting on the length of road specified in Article 2 between the hours of 8.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on the days Monday to Saturday inclusive. Vehicles are excepted from the prohibition in certain circumstances.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
