ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

**The One-Way Traffic (Ballyclare) Order (Northern Ireland)
2016**

Made - - - - - *8th July 2016*

Coming into operation - *1st August 2016*

The Department for Infrastructure^(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997^(b) and now vested in it^(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The One-Way Traffic (Ballyclare) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on 1st August 2016.

Prohibition

2. A person shall not, except upon the direction or with the permission of a constable in uniform cause or permit any vehicle to proceed on the road or length of road specified in column 1 of the Schedule in a direction other than that specified in relation to those roads in column 2.

Revocation

3. The One-Way Traffic (Ballyclare) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993^(d) is revoked.

Article 2

ONE-WAY TRAFFIC IN BALLYCLARE

	<i>Column 1</i>	<i>Column 2</i>
1.	Bellevue Place, from a point 45 metres south-east of its continuation with Bellevue Street for a distance of 100 metres.	South-westerly
2.	The Square.	Clockwise

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order introduces a one-way system on the length of Bellevue Place, Ballyclare as specified in item 1 of the Schedule.

The Order also revokes and re-enacts the one-way system on The Square, Ballyclare, included in the One-Way Traffic (Ballyclare) Order (Northern Ireland) 1993 (S.R. 1993 No. 260).

Any person who acts in contravention of the Order shall be guilty of an offence under the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997 (“the Regulation Order”) and shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale (£1,000) in accordance with The Road Traffic Offenders (Northern Ireland) Order 1996 as amended by the Regulation Order.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
