# **PUBLIC HEALTH**

The Tobacco Retailer (Fixed Penalty)
(General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2016

Made - - - - 2nd March 2016
Coming into operation 1st July 2016

The Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety makes the following Regulations, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 12(7) and 24(3) of the Tobacco Retailers Act (Northern Ireland) 2014(1).

#### Citation and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Tobacco Retailer (Fixed Penalty) (General) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2016 and shall come into operation on 1st July 2016.

## Form of fixed penalty notice

2. A fixed penalty notice shall be in the form set out in the Schedule.
