The Agriculture (Student fees)(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2017

Made - - - -Coming into operation 20th July 2017 1st September 2017

The Department of Agriculture, Environment and Rural Affairs(1), in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 5A(1) and (2) of the Agriculture Act (Northern Ireland) 1949(2), makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Agriculture (Student fees)(Amendment) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2017 and shall come into operation on the 1st September 2017.

Amendment to the Agriculture (Student fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007

2. The Agriculture (Student fees) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2007(**3**) shall be amended as provided by regulations 3 and 4.
