## **ROADS**

The Carryduff Road and Saintfield Road, Temple Crossroads, Lisburn (Abandonment and Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017

Made - - - - 19th January 2017

Coming into operation - 26th April 2017

The Department for Infrastructure(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1), (3) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order proposes on the completion of works providing alternative facilities for road traffic to abandon the area of Carryduff Road as described in Part 1 of the Schedule and to stop-up Carryduff Road and Saintfield Road to road traffic at the lines described in Part 2 of the Schedule.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

One objection has been received and subsequently withdrawn.

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as The Carryduff Road and Saintfield Road, Temple Crossroads, Lisburn (Abandonment and Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2017 and shall come into operation on 26th April 2017.

## **Application**

- 2.—(1) The Department shall carry out such works as the Department considers necessary for the provision of alternative facilities for road traffic and on the completion of works the area of Carryduff Road described in Part 1 of the Schedule shall be abandoned and Carryduff Road and Saintfield Road shall be stopped-up to road traffic at the lines described in Part 2 of the Schedule.
- (2) The Department shall carry out such works as it considers necessary to prevent or restrict to such extent as the Department thinks fit, access to the roads by road traffic.

- **3.**—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the abandoned area of road and the stopped-up roads shall be removed.
- (2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be extinguished.

#### AREA OF ROAD TO BE ABANDONED

An area of 890 square metres of carriageway and verge of Carryduff Road, Temple Crossroads, Lisburn adjacent to numbers 88-90 Carryduff Road, more particularly delineated and shown hatched and coloured red on Map No. IN1/16/347966.

- **1.** Carryduff Road, Temple Crossroads, Lisburn at a line adjacent to number 86 Carryduff Road more particularly delineated and marked A-B on Map No. IN1/16/347966.
- **2.** Saintfield Road, Temple Crossroads, Lisburn at its junction on the west side of Carryduff Road more particularly delineated and marked C-D on Map No. IN1/16/347966.
