The Taxis (Ballynahinch) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019

17th July 2019 7th August 2019

The Department for Infrastructure(**a**) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by Article 27A(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(**b**) and now vested in it(**c**).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4A to that Order(d).

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as The Taxis (Ballynahinch) Order (Northern Ireland) 2019 and shall come into operation on 7th August 2019.

(2) In this Order-

"taxi" has the meaning given in Article 27A(4) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

Location and number of taxis

2. No stand for taxis shall be used except that specified in column 2 of the Schedule in relation to the location specified opposite thereto in column 1, their number shall not exceed that specified in column 3 and the hours available for use shall be as stated in column 4.

Use of stand or starting place

3. No vehicle other than a taxi shall use the stand specified in column 2 of the Schedule at any time.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prescribes the precise location which may be used as a stand for taxis in the town of Ballynahinch, the maximum number of taxis which may use that stand and the hours available for use. The Order also prohibits vehicles other than taxis from using the stand.

This Order also revokes the Taxis (Ballynahinch) Bye-Laws (Northern Ireland) 2004.

A penalty charge (£90) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.
