ROAD TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES

The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment No. 8) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021

Made - - - - 24th November 2021

Coming into operation - 15th December 2021

The Department for Infrastructure(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Articles 10(4), 13(1) and (16) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

It appears to the Department to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule.

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 4 to the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997.

The Department has published a notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

The Department in compliance with paragraph 3(4) of that Schedule, has taken such other steps as appear to the Department reasonably practicable for the purpose of bringing specifically to the knowledge of the occupiers of land adjacent to the parking places the particulars specified in paragraph 3(2) of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) (Amendment No. 8) Order (Northern Ireland) 2021 and shall come into operation on 15th December 2021.

"2972.	Haywood Drive, Belfast (east side) – from a point 36 metres south of its junction with Candahar Street for a distance of 5.5 metres in a southerly direction.
2973.	Horn Drive, Belfast (north-west side of a parking area to the side of No. 54) – from a point 78 metres east of its junction with Derryveagh Drive for a distance of 6 metres in a north-easterly direction.
2974.	Castlecoole Park, Belfast (west side) – from a point 51 metres north-west of its southern junction with Castledillon Road for a distance of 6.6 metres in a northerly direction.
2975.	St Jude's Parade, Belfast (north side) – from a point 68.5 metres west of its junction with Ravenhill Road for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction.
2976.	St Jude's Parade, Belfast (north side) – from a point 79.5 metres west of its junction with Ravenhill Road for a distance of 5.5 metres in a westerly direction.
2977.	Willowbank Gardens, Belfast (south side) – from a point 91 metres west of its junction with Antrim Road for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction.
2978.	Derg View, Castlederg (south-west side of a parking area to the rear of No. 22) – from a point 146 metres south-east and then south-west of its junction with Killeter Road for a distance of 6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
2979.	Reihill Park, Irvinestown (south-west side of north-east parking area) - from a point 182 metres north-east and then north-west of its junction with Church Street for a distance of 3 metres in a north-westerly direction.
2980.	Corrody Road, Londonderry (south-east side) – from a point 15 metres south-west of its junction with Trench Road for a distance of 6 metres in a south-westerly direction.
2981.	Leckagh Walk, Magherafelt (north-east side of a parking area to the rear of No. 22) – from a point 36 metres north-west of its junction with Leckagh Drive for a distance of 6 metres in a north-westerly direction.
2982.	Catalina Gardens, Newtownards (east side of a parking area in front of No. 7) – from a point 105 metres west of its junction with Blenheim Drive for a distance of 2.4 metres in a southerly direction.
2983.	James Street, Newtownards (west side) – from a point 85 metres south of its junction with Talbot Street for a distance of 5 metres in a south-westerly direction."

This Order amends The Parking Places (Disabled Persons' Vehicles) Order (Northern Ireland) 2016.

The amendments provide for the introduction of parking places with unlimited waiting on the lengths of the roads specified in the Schedule and the removal of the parking places referred to in Article 2(2).
