1630. February 12. CREDITORS of FAIRLY against His HEIRS.

Ir a creditor pursue registration of a bond both against the heir of line and and conquest, the heir of line offers to renounce, the heir of conquest oppones to the renunciation, and alleges no registration can be decerned against him, till the heir of line were first discussed;—The Lords ordain registration against both the heirs, but suspend execution till the heir of line be first discussed.
