Replied for the pursuer; Imo, That such a clause in the defender's charter can never afford him any title to exact a herezeld from a vassal, whose reddendo is his sole rule. 2do, The constant use of such an oppression rather loads than excuses the defender.

THE LORDS found Tillibole liable in repetition; to which their Lordship adhered, after a reclaiming bill, without answers.
