EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order brings section 23 of the Education (Additional Support for Learning) (Scotland) Act 2009 ("the Act") into force on 14th November 2010. The whole of the Act will be in force from that date.

Section 23 of the Act makes provision for the collection of data on additional support needs by the Scottish Ministers from education authorities and the publication by the Scottish Ministers of that information.
