## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A92 Trunk Road (Leuchars Airshow) (Temporary 30 mph Speed Restriction) Order 2011

Made 31st August 2011

Coming into force 10th September 2011

The Scottish Ministers make the following order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1), 4(1) and 14(1)(b) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(b) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public which is not attributable to works that are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said length of road.

### Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A92 Trunk Road (Leuchars Airshow) (Temporary 30 mph Speed Restriction) Order 2011, comes into force at 0001 hours on 10th September 2011 and ceases to have effect at 0001 hours on 11th September 2011.

#### **Temporary speed restriction**

2. No person shall use, or permit the use of any vehicle on the length of road specified in the Schedule at a speed exceeding 30mph when a restriction is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

## **Exemptions**

3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
