## **ROAD TRAFFIC**

# The A83 Trunk Road (Poltalloch Street, Lochgilphead) (Special Event) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act  $1984(\mathbf{a})$  and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 16A(2) of that Act, they are satisfied that traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the holding of the Lochgilphead Armed Forces Day 2012, and enabling members of the public to watch that event.

In accordance with section 16A(3) of that Act, they are satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for that event to be held otherwise than on that length of road.

In accordance with section 16A(8) of that Act, they have had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

#### Citation, commencement and cessation

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A83 Trunk Road (Poltalloch Street, Lochgilphead) (Special Event) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012, comes into force on 23rd June 2012 and ceases to have effect on 24th June 2012.

#### Prohibition of use of vehicles

**2.** No person shall use, or permit the use of any vehicle on the length of road, or part or parts of the length of road, specified in the Schedule when such prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or that part or parts of the length of road, by means of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagrams 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(**b**).

### Exemptions

3. This Order does not apply to—

- (a) a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance, or police purposes;
- (b) or a vehicle while being used in connection with the placing of the required signage; or
- (c) anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

## SCHEDULE

Article 2

That length of the A83 Tarbet – Lochgilphead – Kennacraig Trunk Road known as Poltalloch Street, Lochgilphead from its junction with Argyll Street, Lochgilphead to its junction with Lorne Street, Lochgilphead, a distance of 230 metres or thereby.
