# The South East Scotland Trunk Roads (Temporary Prohibitions of Traffic and Overtaking and Temporary Speed Restrictions) (No. 2) Order 2012

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(**a**) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said lengths of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

#### Citation, commencement and cessation

**1.** This Order may be cited as the South East Scotland Trunk Roads (Temporary Prohibitions of Traffic and Overtaking and Temporary Speed Restrictions) (No. 2) Order 2012, comes into force on 1st March 2012 and ceases to have effect on 1st June 2012.

#### Interpretation

**2.** In this Order a reference to a numbered column is to the column in the Schedule to this Order bearing that number.

#### Temporary prohibition on use of a road

**3.** No person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on a length of road, or a part or parts of a length of road, specified in column 1 when such a prohibition is identified as applying to that

length of road, or a part or parts of a length of road, by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations  $2002(\mathbf{a})$ .

#### Temporary prohibition on overtaking

**4.** -(1) No person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle in such a way that it overtakes any other moving vehicle on a length of road, or a part or parts of a length of road, specified in column 1 when such a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of a length of road, by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 632 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002.

(2) "Other moving vehicle" does not include a cycle, motor cycle, tricycle or any other vehicle not being a motor vehicle in accordance with section 140 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act  $1984(\mathbf{b})$ .

#### **Temporary speed restriction**

**5.**—(1) No person shall drive any vehicle on a length of road specified in column 1 of Parts 2 and 3 of the Schedule at a speed exceeding that specified in column 2 when a restriction is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of a length of road, by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002.

(2) When convoy working is in operation and indicated by one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagrams 7011, 7025, 7026, 7027, 7028 and 7029 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002, no person shall drive any vehicle on a length of road specified in column 1 of Part 3 of the Schedule at a speed exceeding 10 mph when a restriction is identified as applying to a part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002.

#### Exemptions

**6.** No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to vehicles being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes or a vehicle while being used for carrying out the works.

**7.** No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(c) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
