ROAD TRAFFIC

The A92/A972 Trunk Road (Balfarg Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2013

Made - - - - 3rd October 2013

Coming into force - - 14th October 2013

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A92/A972 Trunk Road (Balfarg Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2013, comes into force on 14th October 2013 and ceases to have effect on 31st March 2014.

Prohibition of specified turns

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road, or a part or parts of the length of road, specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagrams 612 and 613 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(**b**).

Exemptions

- 3. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—
 - (a) a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes; or
 - (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

PART 1

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A92/A972 Trunk Road from a point 130 metres or thereby north of the junction with Western Avenue, Glenrothes southwards to a point 50 metres or thereby south of the junction with the C49 to Starr, Glenrothes, a distance of 300 metres or thereby.

PART 2

SPECIFIED TURNS

All right turns from the southbound A92/A972 Trunk Road to Western Avenue, Glenrothes All right turns from Western Avenue, Glenrothes to the southbound A92/A972 Trunk Road All right turns from the northbound A92/A972 Trunk Road to the C49 to Starr, Glenrothes All right turns from the C49 to Starr, Glenrothes to the northbound A92/A972 Trunk Road
