ROAD TRAFFIC

The A82 Trunk Road (Crianlarich Bypass) (Temporary Prohibition of Use) Order 2014

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act $1984(\mathbf{a})$ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be prohibited or restricted because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

In accordance with section 14(1A) of that Act, they have consulted with the affected National Park(**b**).

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Crianlarich Bypass) (Temporary Prohibition of Use) Order 2014, comes into force on 2nd October 2014 and ceases to have effect on 1st April 2015.

Prohibition on use of road

2.—(1) No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road, or a part of parts of the length of road, specified in the Schedule to this Order when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(**c**).

Exemptions

3. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes; or
- (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

That length of the A82 Dalnottar- Inverness Trunk Road, at Crianlarich, from a point 60 metres or thereby south of its junction with the A84/A85 Stirling-Crianlarich Trunk Road at Crianlarich, to a point 1670 metres or thereby south of that point, a total distance of 1670 metres or thereby.
