ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Gladsmuir Junction to Oaktree Junction) (Temporary Prohibition on Use of Road) (No. 2) Order 2015

Made - - - - 30th October 2015

Coming into force - - 1st November 2015

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 62(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 62(1) of that Act, they are of the opinion that considerations of public safety and convenience require that traffic should be temporarily prohibited on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule while filming of the road takes place.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Gladsmuir Junction to Oaktree Junction) (Temporary Prohibition on Use of Road) (No. 2) Order 2015, comes into force on 1st November 2015 and ceases to have effect on 2nd November 2015.

Prohibition on use of road

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road, or a part or parts of the length of road, specified in Part 1 of the Schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(**b**).

Exemptions

- 3. This Order does not apply to:—
 - (a) a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes;
 - (b) a vehicle being used in connection with the filming of the road; or
 - (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the placing of the required signage.

4. The alternative route to be used by traffic when the prohibition referred to in article 2 is operational is specified in Part 2 of the Schedule.

PART 1

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A1 Edinburgh – Berwick Upon Tweed Trunk Road being the northbound and southbound carriageway from Gladsmuir Junction to Oaktree Junction a distance of 4.5 kilometres or thereby.

PART 2

Article 4

ALTERNATIVE ROUTE

Those lengths of road being the A199, B6363, and B6471 between Gladsmuir Junction and Oaktree Junction.
