ROAD TRAFFIC

The M9/A9 Trunk Road (Evanton Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2016

Made - - - - 16th November 2016

Coming into force - - 24th November 2016

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted or prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the M9/A9 Trunk Road (Evanton Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2016, comes into force on 24th November 2016 and ceases to have effect on 30th November 2016.

Prohibition of specified turns

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the schedule of this Order so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road by means of a traffic sign described in item 7 (diagram 612) or item 8 (diagram 613) of the sign table in Part 2 of schedule 3 of the traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(**b**).

Exemptions

- 3. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—
 - (a) a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes; or
 - (b) a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

PART 1

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

1. That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh – Stirling – Thurso Trunk Road from a point about 100 metres or thereby south of its junction with the B817 Evanton Road to a point about 100 metres or thereby north of the B817 Evanton Road, Evanton, a distance of 200 metres or thereby.

PART 2

SPECIFIED TURNS

- 1. All right turns from the southbound M9/A9 Trunk Road to the B817 Evanton Road.
- 2. All right turns from the B817 Evanton Road to the southbound M9/A9 Trunk Road.
- **3.** All left turns from the B817 Evanton Road to the northbound M9/A9 Trunk Road.
