### ROAD TRAFFIC

The A96 Trunk Road (Moss Street, Keith) (Temporary Prohibition on Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (No. 2) Order 2017

*Made - - - - 3rd July 2017* 

Coming into force - - 8th July 2017

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(b) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(b) of that Act, they are satisfied that traffic on the length of road specified in the schedule should be restricted or prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to works.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

#### Citation, commencement and cessation

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A96 Trunk Road (Moss Street, Keith) (Temporary Prohibition on Waiting, Loading and Unloading) (No. 2) Order 2017, comes into force on 8th July 2017 and ceases to have effect on 3rd August 2017.

### Prohibition on waiting, loading and unloading

**2.** No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle to wait, load or unload on the length of road, or a part or parts of the length of road, specified in the schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of one or both of the traffic signs of the types described in item 19 (diagrams 636 – temporary prohibition of waiting except for loading and unloading) and item 20 (diagram 636.1 – temporary prohibition of loading and unloading) of the sign table in Part 6 of schedule 13 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(b).

# Exemptions

**3.** No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes.

# **SCHEDULE**

Article 2

# SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A96 Aberdeen – Inverness Trunk Road, known as Moss Street, Keith, from its junction with Drum Road, Keith southwards to its junction with Denwell Road, Keith, a distance of 887 metres or thereby.
