## ROAD TRAFFIC

# The M90/A90 Trunk Road (Lonmay) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2017

Made - - - - 31st October 2017

Coming into force - - 14th November 2017

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section  $84(2)(\mathbf{b})$  of that Act, the Scottish Ministers have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations  $1987(\mathbf{c})$ .

### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the M90/A90 Trunk Road (Lonmay) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2017 and comes into force on 14th November 2017.

## **Speed restriction**

**2.** No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the schedule.

### **Exemption**

- 3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—
  - (a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces)(Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(**d**) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations; or

Article 2

# SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the M90/A90 Edinburgh to Fraserburgh Trunk Road at Lonmay from a point (at Ordnance Map coordinates 400994.59, 859092.55), 370 metres or thereby west of the centreline of its junction with the U12B Cortiebrae to Cortes Village road, to a point (at Ordnance Map coordinates 401571.38,858923.22), 230 metres or thereby east of the centreline of that junction, a distance of 600 metres or thereby.
