# **ROAD TRAFFIC**

The A9 Trunk Road (Kincraig to Dalraddy Dualling) (Temporary 40mph Speed Restriction) Revocation Order 2018

Made - - - - 15th January 2018

Coming into force - - 16th January 2018

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1), 14(1)(a) and (4), 15(2) and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of schedule 9 of, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

#### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A9 Trunk Road (Kincraig to Dalraddy Dualling) (Temporary 40mph Speed Restriction) Revocation Order 2018 and comes into force on 16th January 2018.

### Revocation

**2.** The A9 Trunk Road (Kincraig to Dalraddy Dualling) (Temporary 40mph Speed Restriction) Order 2015(**b**) is revoked.
