ROAD TRAFFIC

The A78 Trunk Road (Fairlie) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2019

Made---30th May 2019Coming into force-13th June 2019

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 84(1)(a), and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of schedule 9 of, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section $84(2)(\mathbf{b})$ of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(\mathbf{c}).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A78 Trunk Road (Fairlie) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 2019 and comes into force on 13 June 2019.

Speed restriction

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the schedule.

Revocation

3. The Trunk Roads (Route A78) (Restricted Road) (Fairlie) Order 1984(d) is revoked.

Exemption

4. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

(a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(e) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations, or

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A78 Greenock - Prestwick Trunk Road at Fairlie from a point 53 metres or thereby north of the access road to Baillie Road southwards to a point in line with the southernmost kerbline of the private road to Southannan Estate, a distance of 2.317 kilometres or thereby.
