# **ROAD TRAFFIC**

# The A83 Trunk Road (Furnace to Cumlodden) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2019

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section  $84(2)(\mathbf{b})$  of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987( $\mathbf{c}$ ).

### Citation and commencement

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A83 Trunk Road (Furnace to Cumlodden) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2019 and comes into force on 8 August 2019.

### **Speed restriction**

**2.** No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the schedule.

#### Exemption

3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

(a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(d) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations, or

## SCHEDULE

Article 2

## SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A83 Tarbet – Lochgilphead – Campbeltown Trunk Road from a point 1.242 kilometres or thereby south west of the extended centre line of the junction with the C36 Furnace Side Road to a point 130 metres or thereby south west of the point where that trunk road meets the extended western gable wall of Number 1 Cumlodden Cottages, a distance of 1.558 kilometres or thereby.
