The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 153 of the Local Government etc. (Scotland) Act 1994(1) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Non-Domestic Rates (Enterprise Areas) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2020 and come into force on 31 March 2020.

Amendment of the Non-Domestic Rates (Enterprise Areas) (Scotland) Regulations 2016

2. In regulation 3 of the Non-Domestic Rates (Enterprise Areas) (Scotland) Regulations 2016(**2**) for "2020" substitute "2022".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Non-Domestic Rates (Enterprise Areas) (Scotland) Regulations 2016, which provide relief from non-domestic rates in specified enterprise areas.

The relief granted under those Regulations would expire on 31 March 2020, but regulation 2 of these Regulations extends the relief until 31 March 2022.
