ROAD TRAFFIC

The A82 Trunk Road (Fort Augustus) (Temporary Prohibition on Waiting) Order 2024

Made - - - - 19th March 2024

Coming into force - - 29th March 2024

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(b) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(b) of that Act, they are satisfied that traffic on the lengths of road specified in the schedule should be restricted or prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public, or of serious damage to the road, which is not attributable to works.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Fort Augustus) (Temporary Prohibition on Waiting) Order 2024, comes into force on 29 March 2024 and ceases to have effect on 30 October 2024.

Prohibition on waiting

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle to wait on the lengths of road, or a part or parts of the lengths of road, specified in the schedule when a prohibition is identified as applying to those lengths of road, or a part or parts of those lengths of road, by means of a traffic sign of the type described in item 19 (diagram 636 – temporary prohibition of waiting except for loading and unloading) of the sign table in Part 6 of schedule 13 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016(b).

Exemptions

3. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTHS OF ROAD

West Side

1. That length of the A82 Dalnottar – Inverness Trunk Road at Fort Augustus from a point 30 metres north east of the north kerbline of Bunoich Brae junction south west and south for a distance of 546 metres or thereby.

East Side

2. That length of the A82 Dalnottar – Inverness Trunk Road at Fort Augustus from a point 30 metres north east opposite the north kerbline of Bunoich Brae junction south west and south for a distance of 546 metres or thereby.
