	The Complaint failed to expressly identify the rights relied upon but I am persuaded that it is more likely than not that the Complainant has "unregistered trade mark rights" in the terms "GTCC" and "Guildford Street Angels" by reason

of use of the same since 2008.

The basis for the finding of abusive registration is by reference to, or alternatively by analogy with, paragraph 3(a)(v) of the Policy. It would appear from the material provided that the Complainant has not paid for the registration or renewal of the domain names. But it is clear from the material provided that the parties were agreed that this would occur and that the only reason why payment was not made was because the Respondent did not submit an invoice.
