## 7. Comments (optional)

The Complaint is far too sparse. The claim to rights is a claim to unregistered rights, but the evidence comprises a 2013 brochure, 3 modest invoices and a Companies' Registry document, which expressly states that it is a receipt for information provided, not confirmation of anything of substance. Nonetheless, if the evidence as to Abusive Registration had been of substance, I might have been prepared to make an assumption in the Complainant's favour. However, the case on Abusive Registration is all bare assertion. If I had to guess the Complainant's case, it is that the domain name is held by someone else who designed the complainant's website. However, the Expert should not be left to guess. No evidence has been supplied to support the assertions, not even a screenshot of the website or any material to indicate how it came to be designed and connected to the domain name.

## 8. Decision

I refuse the Complainant's application for a summary decision. The domain name registration will therefore remain with the Respondent.
