The Complaint comprises a cursory statement of the situation as the Complainant sees it. There is no evidence to support a claim of rights in a name identical or similar to the Domain Name as required under the DRS Policy.

An exchange of emails between the Complainant's representative and the Respondent is annexed to the Complaint. This suggests a misunderstanding, or possibly something more contentious, between the parties. However, I am unable to infer an abusive registration prejudicial to the Complainant's rights from such a limited submission.
