#### 7. Comments (optional)

The <etech.co.uk> Domain Name was registered on 24 April 2003 and the <etech.uk> Domain Name was registered on 30 August 2014.

The incorporation of the Complainant did not take place until May 2016. There is no suggestion that this is a continuation of some other business under the "etech" name.

The <etech.co.uk> Domain Name has been used for a pay-per-click webpage with technology related links since at least December 2013. No evidence has been provided as to how the <etech.uk> Domain Name has been used. It is not alleged that the nature of those links has materially changed following the Complainant's incorporation

Accordingly the Complainant has failed to demonstrate that the use made by the Respondent of the Domain Names has sought to take unfair advantage of the Complainant's rights.

### 8. Decision

I refuse the Complainant's application for a summary decision. The domain name registrations will therefore remain with the Respondent.
