(a) until the Domain Name became inaccessible by reason of the Respondent's dissolution, the Complainant had been using the Domain Name registration exclusively; and

(b) it paid for the registration of the Domain Name.

Accordingly, the Complainant has, pursuant to paragraph 12.5.2 of the Policy, shown that it has Rights (as defined) in respect of a name or mark identical or similar to the Domain Name, and that the Domain Name is, in the hands of the Respondent, an Abusive Registration (as defined).

8 Decision

In accordance with paragraph 12 of the Policy, I therefore grant the Complainant's application for a summary decision. The Domain Name will therefore be transferred to the Complainant.
