JUDGMENT

16 17 MR

JUSTICE MITTING: I grant the application to add one hour to the non-curfew hours during British summer time. I do so because this appellant's litigation is unlikely to conclude in the near future, because there are signs which I wish to encourage of a radical change in attitude by him, and by this means I propose to reward trustworthy behaviour by him, and to encourage what I have every reason to believe is a genuine change in attitude, even though of course I must always bear in mind that it might not be genuine. For the time being I am prepared to believe that it is; I think it is more likely than not that it is.
