# **NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL**

- The First-tier Tribunal determination in this appeal was set aside by a decision of Deputy Upper Tribunal Judge Rimington, on the respondent's application, on 4 August 2014 and the determination is to be remade in the Upper Tribunal.
