## NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL AND REASONS FOR THE TRIBUNAL GIVING CONSENT

- 1. The appellant by letter dated 8 December 2013 (received 8 May 2014) states that he wishes to withdraw his appeal. It appears that the letter is wrongly dated as it pre-dates the grant of permission.
