NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL

1. The Secretary of State was granted permission to appeal to the Upper Tribunal against a determination of Judge of the First-tier Tribunal Parker promulgated on 14th April 2014.

Appeal Number: IA/42512/2013

2. Judge Parker had allowed the Appellant's appeal under the Immigration Rules, and under Article 8 of the 1950 European Convention on Human Rights.
