#### **DECISION**

- 1. The appellant has an appeal outstanding before the Upper Tribunal. By letter dated 24 March 2014 the appellant states that she wishes to withdraw her appeal.
- 2. Rule 17 of the Tribunal Procedure (Upper Tribunal) Rules 2008 provides that a party may give notice of the withdrawal of its case or any part of it, subject to the consent of the Upper Tribunal. There is no provision for a party to withdraw the appeal before the Upper Tribunal. Therefore, the letter from the appellant can serve only as a notice of withdrawal of her case before the Upper Tribunal, to which the Upper Tribunal now consents.
- 3. Accordingly, the appellant's appeal to the Upper Tribunal is dismissed and the decision of the First-tier Tribunal to dismiss her appeal therefore stands.
