NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL AND

REASONS FOR THE TRIBUNAL GIVING CONSENT

- 1. The Secretary of State is the appellant before the Upper Tribunal. She obtained permission to appeal to the Upper Tribunal against a decision of the First-tier Tribunal promulgated on 10 August 2015 allowing the appellants' appeals on Refugee Convention grounds.
- 2. By way of emails dated 18 and 19 November 2015 the Respondent seeks to withdraw her case before the Upper Tribunal.
- Consent of the Upper Tribunal is required for a party to withdraw its case.
 Having carefully considered the facts of this appeal as a whole, and
 observing the terms of the First-tier Tribunal's decision and the agreement
 between the parties, I give such consent to the Secretary of State to
