NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL AND REASONS FOR THE TRIBUNAL GIVING CONSENT

- 1. The appellant is a citizen of Bangladesh who appealed to the First-tier Tribunal against the decision of the Secretary of State of 25 February 2014. The First-tier Tribunal dismissed the appeals in a determination promulgated on 20 November 2014. Upper Tribunal Judge Coker granted the appellant permission to appeal to the Upper Tribunal.
- 2. By way of a letter to the Upper Tribunal dated 15 May 2015 the appellant states that he wishes to withdraw his appeal.
- 3. Consent of the Upper Tribunal is required for a party to withdraw its case. Having carefully considered the facts of this appeal as a whole, and observing that the Secretary of State was the successful party before the First-tier Tribunal, I give such consent to the appellant to withdraw his case.
