NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL AND REASONS FOR THE TRIBUNAL GIVING CONSENT

- The Secretary of State for the Home Department appeals with permission against the decision of the First-tier Tribunal (FtT) (Judge N M K Lawrence) promulgated on 27th April 2015 allowing the appeal of Mr Sargsyan, a national of Armenia, (hereafter "the claimant") on human rights grounds contrary to Article 8 of the European Convention on Human Rights.
- 2. At the hearing the Secretary of State's representative, Mr I Jarvis, made a request to withdraw the appeal.
- 3. Consent of the Upper Tribunal is required for a party to withdraw its case. Having carefully considered the facts of this appeal as a whole, and observing that the claimant was the successful party before the FtT, we give such consent for the case to be withdrawn.

- 4. Accordingly with our consent, and pursuant to rule 17(5) of the Tribunal Procedure (Upper Tribunal) Rules 2008, this appeal is recorded as "Withdrawn with the consent of the Upper Tribunal". This is a Notice pursuant to rule 17(5) to inform the parties that the Secretary of State's case is withdrawn.
- 5. The effect of the withdrawal is that the proceedings before the Upper Tribunal are at an end. There is no appeal before the Upper Tribunal and the FtT's decision shall stand.
