# NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL AND REASONS FOR THE TRIBUNAL GIVING CONSENT

- 1. The Secretary of State is the appellant before the Upper Tribunal. She obtained permission to appeal to the Upper Tribunal against a decision of the First-tier Tribunal promulgated on 9 June 2015 allowing Mr Isichei's appeal against a decision refusing to vary his leave.
- By way of a letter dated 26 October 2015 the Respondent seeks to withdraw her case before the Upper Tribunal. Mr Isechei has expressed no objection to such a course being taken.
- 3. Consent of the Upper Tribunal is required for a party to withdraw its case. Having carefully considered the facts of this appeal as a whole, and observing the terms of the First-tier Tribunal's decision and the agreement between the parties as to the appropriate course, I give such consent to the Secretary of State to withdraw.
