#### JUDGMENT

The unanimous judgment of the tribunal is: -

#### Liability:

- 1) The claimant succeeds in her claim that the respondent failed in its duty to make reasonable adjustments for her as a disabled person; pursuant to s.20 & s.21 Equality Act 2010 (EqA).
- 2) The claimant succeeds in her claim (under s.15 EqA) of discrimination arising from her disability. Her dismissal on 23 November 2015 was discriminatory and in breach of s.15
- 4) The claimant succeeds/fails in her claim of direct discrimination (under s.13 EqA).
- 5) The claimant has proven her claim of breach of contract; but has suffered no consequential loss.

### Remedy:

6) We award the claimant compensation for discrimination and associated financial loss in the total sum of £30,851.56 including interest pursuant to the Employment Tribunals (Interest on Awards in Discrimination Cases) (Amendment) Regulations 2013.
