- 4. The claimant is responsible for any income tax or employee national insurance contributions that may be due on the sum awarded for unpaid wages.

5. The claimant has received a part payment of £927.52 (<u>net</u>) from The Secretary of State for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (The Insolvency Service) in respect of the claim. The claimant is aware that payments from The Insolvency Service are limited to 8 weeks arrears of wages.
